Candidate List of 163 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

Dear Valued Customer,

The Candidate List of 163 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC substances) subject to authorization has been published by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) on its website on June 15, 2015 in accordance with Article 59 (10) of REACH Regulation.

As a manufacturer of “articles” within the meaning of the Regulation, ETI Systems is subject to the obligation to inform its customers in line with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation if any of the products supplied by us contains a substance of very high concern (SVHC) in a mass concentration (w/w) of more than 0.1 percent. The current SVHC list includes 163 different chemicals. This list has been published by the Europe-an Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and can be accessed under <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>

- ETI Systems keeps in touch with all suppliers used in the manufacturing of our products, requiring each of them to provide information as to whether listed sub-stances of very high concern (SVHC) are contained in the raw materials in concentrations above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w).
- EU suppliers of products used in the manufacture of our products in relevant quantities are equally under an obligation to inform us without delay, and of their own accord, if any of the products supplied by them contains a substance of very high concern in a mass concentration above 0.1%. Should we receive any such information from our suppliers and should it turn out that the 0.1% threshold is exceeded for any SVHC in our products as well, we will let you know at once.

Therefore, to the best of our knowledge none of the 163 SVHC substances are intentionally added or used in the manufacturing of ETI products exceeding 0.1 percent.
