EU Sanctions on Russian and Belarusian Iron and Steel

June 2, 2026

To Whom It May Concern:

Concerning Iron & Steel products: According to Article 3g Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 (concerning Russia) and Article 1q of Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 (concerning Belarus), it is prohibited to directly or indirectly import, purchase or transport certain iron and steel products listed in Annex XVII to Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 and Annex XII to Regulation (EC) No 765/2006.

ETI Systems is fully committed to complying with all international trade regulations, including the European Union's sanctions against imports of iron and steel products originating from Russia and Belarus.

We want to assure our valued customers and partners that our products do not contain any iron or steel melted or poured in Russia or Belarus. We have robust supply chain management processes in place to ensure ongoing compliance.

For the iron and steel components used in our products, we source from trusted and verified suppliers. This commitment ensures that all materials meet stringent quality standards and adhere to ethical and legal sourcing practices.
